- To ensure remedial action depending upon the gravity of the grievance.

## ETC-SGRC FUNCTIONS:

- To implement appropriate mechanisms to handle the reported grievances.
- To listen, record and scrutinize the grievance file by the students
- To protect privacy of confidentiality of included parties during the investigation.
- To ensure speedy disposal of every grievance filed by the students-within one month.

### ETC-SGRC PROCEDURE:

Students can file their grievances through any of the following modes.

Mode 1: Directly to the SGRC

The grievances shall be addressed to the students grievance cell directly.

Mode 2: Optional teacher / mentor

The grievances shall be addressed to the concerned optional teacher or mentor.

Mode 3: The Principal

Students directly approach the principal to file the grievances.

Mode 4: Complaint box:

Students put their complaint or problem into the suggestion box.
